1	C	Il Banchetto Sangiovese Rubicone Italy This is a fresh, dry red with some classic Sangiovese character: Crisp cherry and raspberry fruit with ripe tannins and a wave of refreshing acidity on the finish. A perfect pizza/pasta wine.	£2.50	£4.20	£13.50
2	D	Santiano Cabernet Sauvignon Chile The wine is full-bodied and lively, with good structure and spicy tannins. The mint accent carries through on the medium-long finish.			£13.60
3	D	Basking Lizard Shiraz Australia The wine is of deep red colour. The nose is reminiscent of blackberry and liquorice with a cracked pepper spice overtone. The palate is rich, rounded with soft tannins providing a lingering fruit-driven finish.			£13.90
4	C	Wandering Bear Merlot USA Fruity and lush beyond belief. So easy to drink it is scary! This wine is sumptuous and full with plum, cherry and vanilla tones. A gorgeous combination.			£14.50
5		Côtes du Rhône François Bour France Intense ruby colour with a complex bouquet of ripe fruits and spices. Well balanced, subtle and fruity palate with structured tannins.			£15.30
6	B	Castillo De Clavijo Rioja Crianza Spain Aromas of ripe red-berries, spices and vanilla. Elegant and harmonious on the palate, with a long finish in which the very ripe fruit flavours dominate, with a reminder of its time in the barrel			£16.70
